

This message plays into financial gain - a lot of people like getting money! If you weren't expecting this and/or don't recognize why, it's always wise to verify the sender and the link before clicking and providing any information.



Social engineering tactic:

This message plays into free stuff - a lot of people like getting free phones! Remember - if it sounds too good to be true, it probably is - especially if it comes out of nowhere! More often than not, these are scams designed to either get personal information for other (often nefarious) purposes.

Social engineering tactic:

This message plays into personal emotions. In today's situation, work-from-home can trigger feelings of worry, anxiety, excitement or even annoyance - as a result, sometimes readers will click on the link without pausing to check for phishing indicators. If you are ever faced with this type of email, some immediate checks you can do is to validate the sender and the link - official PETRONAS emails will typically use the PETRONAS email domain and use approved tools or sites (i.e. NOT www. solutionfun.info!).

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

Social engineering tactic:

This message plays into panic - nobody likes having their salary delayed. However it's important to remember that emails asking for employee information for company use should always come from a company email - that's the first sign there is something wrong with this message. Knowing to check for the phishing indicators may also help you to identify what is a valid request for information vs. one that is phishing you for your personal information.

Social engineering tactic:

This message plays into both curiosity and perhaps panic what did my supervisor say? Similar to queries for personal information, this type of company-related process should come from a company email address. Alongside other common indicators, it's also worth noting that most company systems have a name - 'secure website' is a little suspicious, so it's always worth hovering over the link to check if it really is a PETRONAS website.
